Cultural Heritage



The "Weaving Opportunities" project at the Pachacamac Sanctuary trained 24 low-income artisans in dyeing and weaving techniques, enabling them to create products with cultural iconography and improve their quality of life. This initiative benefited the artisans, their families, visitors, and the local community, promoting heritage conservation and economic development.

Among its achievements are the revaluation of traditional craft techniques, the empowerment of participants, the strengthening of cultural identity, and the establishment of a replicable community management model. The project required an investment of **USD 12,220.00** from Turismo Cuida, benefiting heritage preservation and sustainable development, with strategic partners including SPI and the Pachacamac Site Museum.

Objective

Turismo Cuida supports this initiative aimed at boosting the economy of low-income communities in Lurín, Villa María del Triunfo, Pachacamac, and Villa El Salvador by developing artisanal products for women of SISAN, enhancing their cultural identity, and promoting the conservation of the Pachacamac Sanctuary's heritage.
